Develop a clearly defined student culture that is both intentionally college-preparatory and focused on student responsibility and accountability.

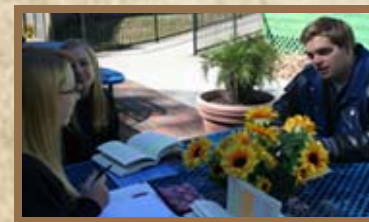


# Our History
